

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-6-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE OF CLINTON COUNTY, INDIANA AND THE TOWN OF KIRKLIN

WHEREAS, The Area Plan Commission of Clinton County has held a public hearing in accordance with law on certain proposed amendments to the Unified Development Ordinance of Clinton County, Indiana, and thereafter by vote regarding said proposed amendments, all in accordance with the Area Planning Act, I.C. 36-7-4-100 et Seq. as amended; and,

WHEREAS, The Town Council of Kirclin, Indiana has given notice as required per I.C. 5-14-1.5-5; and, has held a public meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Kirclin, Indiana has determined that all requirements under I.C. 36-7-4-605, I.C. 36-7-4-606, I.C. 36-7-4-607; and I.C. 36-7-4-608 have been met.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of Kirclin, State of Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. Said Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) of Clinton County, Indiana, approved and passed on 10th day of August, 2015, including any addendum thereto, and any amendments thereto adopted, set forth in said Ordinance be, and the same is hereby further amended, supplemented, and changed in the following respects:

Adopt a new UDO 1102.05 to read as follows:


1102.05 Confined Feeding & Pasture and Grazing of Livestock: Chickens, Rabbits, and Ducks shall be regulated as follows:

A. Up to 6 chickens or 6 rabbits can be kept in the R-3 district as permitted use. No roosters are permitted, and the animals must be kept in a secure coop or cage. Coops and cages must be 10' from property lines and cleaned regularly. Coops and/or cages shall not be placed between any structure and the road right-of-way. Up to two ducks shall be permitted only upon the granting of a special exception and subject to the above setbacks, coop, cage and cleanliness requirements. No more than a total of six chickens, rabbits, and/or ducks shall be allowed, without a variance.


B. Livestock not specifically listed in this section are prohibited. Outdoor butchering of livestock is also prohibited.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage in accordance with law.
