

**TOWN OF PITTSBORO**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 93.02 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
CONCERNING PROHIBITED ACTIVITY ON PARK PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Pittsboro, Indiana (“Town”) wishes to amend in its entirety Section 93.02 of the Town of Pittsboro Code of Ordinances to prevent vandalism and trespass on the Town park proeprty.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF PITTSBORO, HENDRICKS COUNTY, INDIANA:**

**Section 1.** Section 93.02 Prohibited Activities on Park Property is hereby amended and replaced in its entirety as follows:

**§ 93.02 PROHIBITED ACTIVIITES ON PARK PROPERTY.**

(A) The following activities are prohibited inside or outside of any of the buildings on park property or athletic facilities or fields:

(1) Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages unless otherwise approved as evidenced by a specific permit.

(2) Building or maintaining an open fire or charcoal grill outside of areas purposely designated for such use or approved as evidence by a specific permit.

(3) Creating or causing loud or disturbing noises.

(4) Unpermitted or unauthorized vending.

(5) Allowing animals to roam on park property unleashed.

(6) Skateboarding, roller skating or bicycle riding on any park structure, statue, buildings or playground equipment.

(7) Minors under the age of seventeen (17) on park property without the supervision of an adult, parent or guardian.

(8) Trespassing or otherwise being on park property after posted hours park is open unless approved by specific permit.

(9) Climbing on the roof of any structure.

(10) Operation of any vehicle, motorized or unmotorized, in any reckless manner on park property.

(11) Littering.

(12) Loitering.

(13) Mischief or any vandalism on park property.

(B) Any violation of subparts (A) (1) through (5) will be subject to a citation of a fine of not more than \$100 for each and every offense cited. Any violation of provisions in subparts (A)(6) through (13) will be subject to a citation of a fine of not more than \$1,000 for each and every offense cited, which fine imposed is for the cost of investigating and cleaning up vandalism and damage caused by such prohibited activities on park property and/or an initial payment toward repair of park property; provided, nothing herein shall limit or prohibit the Town from seeking full restitution for its costs including through filing claims in courts of appropriate jurisdiction.

(C) The Town Council authorizes the Town attorney to enforce any provisions of this Ordinance by filing a lawsuit against those responsible for violating this Ordinance in an appropriate court and in addition to any costs, violators shall be responsible for the costs of collection, including court costs and reasonable attorney fees for such action.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect in accordance with Indiana law, upon its passage by the Council, its publication in accordance with the law and upon passage of any applicable waiting period, all as provided by the laws of the State of Indiana. All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby ordered repealed.
